Academic Achievements, Innovations, Sports, Environmental Education & School Initiatives:

The academic year has been a year of **growth, achievement, innovation and meaningful learning** at Nutan Public School. The school continued its endeavour to provide students with a balanced education that nurtures academic excellence, creativity, physical fitness, social responsibility, environmental consciousness and essential life skills.

Academic Excellence:

Academic excellence has remained at the heart of all our endeavours. We are proud to share that the school has **consistently achieved a 100% result in the Board Examinations for the last four consecutive years**, reflecting the sincere efforts of our students, teachers and the continuous support of parents and the management.

As part of our commitment to providing wider academic opportunities, an important decision was taken to introduce **Class XI Commerce**, thereby enabling students to pursue their academic interests within the school and providing them with a broader range of career pathways.

Teacher Capacity Building and Professional Development:

The school strongly believes that **continuous professional development of teachers is essential for improving the quality of education**. During the academic year, all teachers actively participated in **four to five CBSE Capacity Building Programmes and professional training sessions** covering diverse areas of teaching, learning and student development.

These programmes provided teachers with valuable exposure to **NEP 2020, competency-based education, innovative pedagogies, assessment practices, inclusive education, technology integration and other contemporary educational approaches**. The training sessions enabled teachers to update their knowledge, share best practices and strengthen their classroom strategies.

The learning acquired through these CBSE programmes was subsequently integrated into classroom practices, making teaching more **engaging, experiential, competency-oriented and learner-centric**. Such continuous capacity building has helped our teachers remain abreast of changing educational needs and prepare our students for the challenges of the future.

Career Guidance and Counselling:

Recognising the importance of informed career choices at the secondary level, the school organised various **career guidance and counselling programmes for Classes IX and X**. Speed, personality and aptitude assessments were conducted to help students understand their strengths, interests and potential career directions.

Expert career counselling sessions were also organised **by Professor Devanshi Barot and Professor Suchi Shah**, providing students with valuable insights into higher education opportunities, career options and the skills required for future success.

Health, Nutrition and Well-being:

The school continued to focus on developing healthy habits and awareness among students. As part of the **EduFit Expo**, an awareness initiative focusing on **obesity and healthy living** was undertaken.

A special talk and display was organised in collaboration with the **Food and Nutrition Department**, highlighting the importance of healthy eating habits, balanced nutrition and the inclusion of **nutritious foods and millets** in the daily diet.

A thought-provoking session on **sugar consumption and its impact on health** was also conducted **by Ms. Vilasavasti, a respected registered dietitian and nutritionist**. The session encouraged students to become more conscious of their food choices and develop healthier lifestyles.

Innovation and Experiential Learning:

The school continued to promote innovation, technology and learning beyond textbooks. Students participated enthusiastically in [inter-school talent fests and competitions organised by various schools](#), providing them with platforms to showcase their creativity, confidence and diverse talents.

Our students also participated in [SCIPOTECH](#), where the team presented the project “Eco Vision”, based on the theme of sustainability, and secured the [Second Runner-Up position](#). The achievement reflects our emphasis on connecting classroom learning with real-world environmental concerns.

Recognising the growing importance of Artificial Intelligence, an [AI workshop was organised for students](#), providing them with exposure to emerging technologies and encouraging them to become responsible and future-ready learners.

Sports Achievements:

Sports continued to be an integral part of school life, with our students bringing great pride and recognition to the institution through their outstanding performances.

Our students emerged victorious in the [Podar Premier League Cricket Tournament](#) and also secured winning positions in the [WIKA Cup T20 Blast](#) and the [Under-14 Leather Ball Championship](#).

At the [Gyansarovar Sarvodaya Annual Athletics Meet](#), our students displayed exceptional sporting ability and brought home [two Gold and three Silver medals](#) in various events, including the [100m and 200m sprints](#) and [400m relay](#).

[Tanya Sharma](#) was selected to compete at the [State Level KDF State Karate Championship](#), marking another significant achievement in martial arts.

Our students also made their mark at the international level. [Kajal Naidu](#) represented India and won a [Gold Medal in Qatar](#), while [Sumit](#) represented the country at the [Nepal International Championship](#), bringing honour to the school and the nation.

These achievements reflect the dedication, discipline and perseverance of our students and the guidance provided by our sports faculty and coaches.

Environmental Education and Sustainability:

Environmental education has been an important component of the school's educational philosophy. Students were encouraged to understand their responsibility towards nature and become active contributors to a cleaner and greener environment.

The school participated in the “[Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam](#)” initiative supported by the VMC, encouraging students to value and protect our natural environment.

The school community also actively participated in [Swachhotsav – “Ek Din, Ek Ghanta, Ek Saath”](#). The entire team participated in [Shramdaan](#), took the [Swachh Bharat Pledge](#), and contributed towards creating awareness about cleanliness. Students prepared posters carrying meaningful messages on “[Clean India, Green India](#).”

Important occasions such as [World Heritage Day](#), [World Earth Day](#) and [World Environment Day](#) were observed through awareness activities, helping students understand environmental challenges, conservation and the importance of sustainable living.

Fire Safety and Disaster Management:

The safety and preparedness of students and staff continued to receive special attention. The school organised comprehensive [Fire and Safety Awareness and Disaster Management programmes](#).

Experts from the [Fire Department and NDRF team](#) visited the school and conducted demonstrations and awareness sessions. Students and staff were sensitised about emergency preparedness, safety measures, evacuation procedures and responsible action during disasters.

Social Responsibility and Vocal for Local:

The school believes that education must extend beyond academics and nurture responsible and compassionate citizens. Students actively participated in initiatives supporting charitable causes and promoting local products. As part of the “[Vocal for Local](#)” initiative, students organised an [exhibition-cum-sale](#), encouraging appreciation for locally made products while also developing entrepreneurial skills, social responsibility and empathy among learners.

PTA and Parent Partnership:

The school continued to value the partnership between parents and teachers. [PTA meetings and interactions](#) provided a platform for meaningful communication regarding students' academic progress, behaviour, well-being and overall development.
